Program Description

Students enrolled in the Sports Medicine certificate program should have a strong interest in the prevention, evaluation, and treatment of injuries to the physically active. Students will explore subject areas that include risk management, prevention and evaluation of medical and musculoskeletal conditions, therapeutic modalities, therapeutic exercise in rehabilitation, and pharmacology, with the option to deepen their knowledge in anatomy or conduct research. This program aims to advance the knowledge base of a paramedic and better prepare students enrolled in a degree program to work in a sports medicine environment.
